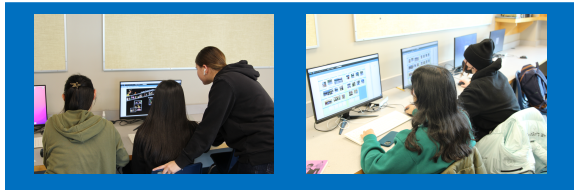
Cambie's A Midsummer Night's Dream
