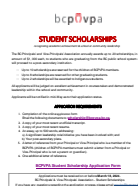
Grade 12 scholarship applications are due Friday, April 5, 2024 by 3:00pm.

Each year HJ Cambie Secondary awards thousands of dollars in scholarships to deserving graduating students. In order to be considered for school-based and district scholarships, students must complete this online application. Our School Scholarship Committee will make the award selections and all scholarships will be presented at the Valedictory ceremony on June 14th at the UBC Chan Centre. Any students with a C+ average or higher are encouraged to apply. The criteria for each scholarship or bursary is unique and it is not necessarily achievement based. **The school offers over 60 scholarships so do not miss out on this opportunity! Please apply by the deadline!**

Scholarship Opportunities

The BC Principals' and Vice-Principals' Association annually awards up to 20 scholarships, in the amount of \$1,000 each, to students who are graduating from the BC public school system and will proceed to a post-secondary institution.



- Up to 10 scholarships are reserved for the children of BCPVPA members.
- Up to 8 scholarships are reserved for other graduating students.
- Up to 2 scholarships will be awarded to Indigenous students.

All applicants will be judged on excellent achievement in courses taken and demonstrated leadership within the school and community. Applicants will be notified in mid-May as to their application status.
