EVALUATION CRITERIA

- poster draws the audience in and keeps their attention
- poster shows how "Richmond is a respectful, safe, caring and connected community that values individual differences."

POSTER SELECTION

- All semi-final designs (chosen by a selection panel) will be posted on the School District's Facebook page with the design with the most combined "likes" selected as this year's winner

LAUNCH AND CAMPAIGN

The winning poster/design will be created and produced as an 11" x 17" poster and launched throughout the community, online and on social media in early 2019 to promote the theme of ERASE Bullying: CREATE CONNECTION and Pink Day February 27, 2019.
