**HALLOWEEN SAFETY:**  
 With Halloween just around the corner, a reminder that students found in possession of any fireworks or firecrackers will be dealt with severely by the school. The Richmond RCMP will be informed and the student will be consequence by the school. Below is a reminder of the firework consequences imposed by the City of Richmond.  
**Fireworks Fines:** Richmond City Bylaw No.7917 specifies the following fines for the use and possession of fireworks:  
 • Purchasing fireworks \$1,000 fine  
 • Selling or distributing fireworks \$1,000 fine  
 • Possession of fireworks w/o a permit \$250 fine  
 Please discuss the above consequences with your son/daughter and confiscate fireworks in their possession.
