**Graduation Numeracy Assessment (GNA)** is required component towards graduation. The exam uses real-world situations where students are solving problems using the 5 numeracy processes: interpret, apply, solve, analyze and communicate.

- Explanations on the unique format of the exam.
- Learning opportunities using sd38 developed resources.
- Guided lessons on strategies for student-choice extended responses.
