Graduation Numeracy Assessment (GNA) is required component towards graduation. The exam uses real-world situations where students are solving problems using the 5 numeracy processes: interpret, apply, solve, analyze and communicate.

All current Grade 10 students will be writing the GNA during one of the session between June 24 to 26. Grade 11 and 12 students who has not yet written the exam or would like to rewrite the exam will also be given the opportunity as well. Preparation will take place in Math 10 classes where students. Grade 11 and 12 students are asked to see Mr. Li for preparation material. Students preparation will commence in June and will include the following:

- Explanations on the unique format of the exam.
- Learning opportunities using sd38 developed resources.
- Guided lessons on strategies for student-choice extended responses.
