Digital Agenda: How to...

Students can record homework and important information in four different ways when they click on a class:

1. Checkmark icon: tasks that need to be completed. To do list items are attached to the class and not the day so they continue to show up for that class until they are checked off. Use this to track the steps of a long-term project.
2. Note icon: Text notes. Use this to enter homework for a class.
3. Camera icon: Photo notes. Use this to take a picture of the board, a page from a book.
4. Bell icon: Reminders and events. Use this to set alarms and track upcoming tests and other due dates.

School Fees:

All secondary schools in Richmond have a standard school fee. This fee covers the cost of a student agenda, locker use, communication fee and some student activity costs. The General School Fee for all students is \$28.00. There are optional and additional activity and enrichment program costs. For instance, the Yearbook may be purchased for \$50.00. Grade 12 students will have optional costs for the Graduation and Valedictory Ceremony, Grad Boat Cruise, Dinner and Dance and Dry Grad.
