The power of curiosity and asking questions contributes not only to high achievement, but also to a fulfilling existence. Curiosity can be defined as the recognition, pursuit, and desire to explore, novel, challenging, and uncertain events. Curiosity has been linked to happiness, creativity, satisfying intimate relationships, increased personal growth after traumatic experiences, and increased meaning in life. In the school context, conceptualized as a “character strength,” and having a “hungry mind.”

Stimulating classroom activities are those that offer novelty, surprise, and complexity, allowing greater autonomy and student choice; they also encourage students to ask questions, question assumptions, and achieve mastery through revision rather than judgment-day-style testing.

Students with curiosity outperform their peers on a wide range of educational outcomes, including math and reading. Curious students work harder and learn more than those that are not encouraged to be curious.
