ELL PROGRAM

I (Beginning) & 2 (Developing)	3 classes of support
3 (Expanding)	2 classes of support
4 (Consolidating)	I class of support
5 (Bridging)	Out of class support

• The remainder of the student's schedule is built around these ELL classes.



CAMBIE COMMONS

- Drop-in learning support available in every block to provide assistance to students.

- Students receive extra support with course work
