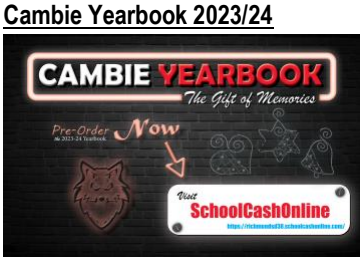
Student Absences:
