Provincial Literacy Graduation Assessments for Grades 10 and 12

Grade 10 and 12 students at Cambie will be writing their Literacy Assessments on **January 23rd**. **They are graduation requirements** that must be completed in order to graduate.

The Grade 10 (GLA 10) and 12 (GLA 12) Literacy Assessments assess students' ability to use critical and reflective thinking and analysis to make meaning from a diverse array of texts. It also assesses the ability of students to communicate their ideas, or those found in the texts. The Grade 12 Literacy assessment is not based on a particular subject matter or course, but rather on learning across multiple subjects from kindergarten to Grade 10/12.

You can help by:

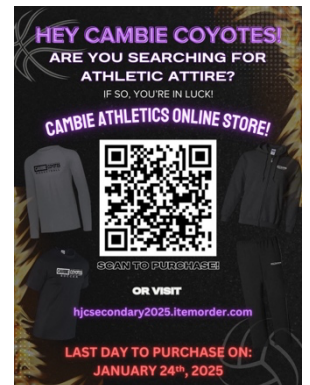
