Student Learning Survey

Students' voices are a big component of the Cambie community, and during a two-week window from February 24 - March 7, our Grade 10, 11 and 12, students will take some time from their class (approx. 30 minutes) to participate in a Ministry student learning survey. The SLS is an annual province-wide census of students in grades 4, 7, 10, 11, and 12, their parents and guardians/caregivers, staff, and principals/vice-principals in schools. These surveys are anonymous, and the information gathered will be used to help support all of our learners. The survey data helps to provide insights in key areas that support students in their growth towards becoming educated citizens. It aims to gather valuable feedback on their experiences at school, including academics, extracurriculars, and overall well-being.

Parent surveys are also available to be completed by parents with children in Grades 4, 7, 10, 11 and 12 at https://www.awinfosys.com/SurveyFull1/central/main/access_Parent.asp until May 2, 2025. It is available in 18 different languages and the survey will take approximately 30 minutes to complete
