NOTE: This role may or may not be filled in any given year depending on the strength and rationale behind individual applications.

Role of the Poet

The Class Poet uses spoken word to reflect upon their experience as a Cambie student, the importance and emotion of the graduation ceremony, and may share a vision for the future. The successful candidate(s) will be chosen based upon the following criteria as identified by Cambie staff and graduates. The students should:

- have very good public speaking skills
- have good academic standing and be on track to graduate this year
- have demonstrated strong citizenship (attitude, behavior, attendance) at Cambie
- possess the ability to present a balanced and inclusive perspective on what graduation means
- be able to relate to a wide range of students in the Graduating Class
- be reflective, thoughtful, and able to express the collective feelings about graduation
- must have attended Cambie Secondary for at least 3 years

How to Apply

The application should be a draft of at least the first stanza of your poem. It should be typed. In addition, it should provide in point form, a list of some of the themes you will convey in your poem/spoken word performance. Any student who is interested in representing the graduating class in this role is asked to apply by **3:00pm on Friday, April 11, 2025.**
