YDI Survey for Grade 11's - February 18

Our Grade 11 students will be writing The Youth Development Instrument (YDI). This online self-reported survey is implemented by researchers from the CHART Lab at Simon Fraser University (SFU), and it helps to identify resources, opportunities and practices that affect positive youth development. It is administered annually and has been in place since 2020.

The YDI collects data that is used collectively, and not individually, to better understand the holistic developmental trends, health and well-being of adolescents in British Columbia. In the Spring Term, we receive a general report that summarizes how our students as a group are doing with their social, emotional and mental health. We use this data to provide a baseline of the overall health of our students in these areas, and it informs the supports we put in place for our students going forward.

Students will be invited to complete the 35 – 40 min online survey. **The YDI will be implemented at our school on February 18, 2026, during our CLC Conference Day.**

If you would prefer that your student not participate in this survey, please fill in the bottom section of the Passive Consent Letter and return it to the school office, or email it to cambie@sd38.bc.ca. Student Learning Survey - Feb 23-27

Students' voices are a big component of the Cambie community, and during a one-week window from February 23 - 27th, our Grade 10, 11 and 12, students will take some time from their class (approx. 30 minutes) to participate in a Ministry student learning survey. The SLS is an annual province-wide census of students in grades 4, 7, 10, 11, and 12, their parents and guardians/caregivers, staff, and principals/vice-principals in schools. These surveys are anonymous, and the information gathered will be used to help support all of our learners. The survey data helps to provide insights in key areas that support students in their growth towards becoming educated citizens. It aims to gather valuable feedback on their experiences at school, including academics, extracurriculars, and overall well-being.

Parent surveys are also available to be completed by parents with children in Grades 4, 7, 10, 11 and 12 at https://www.awinfosys.com/SurveyFull1/central/main/access_Parent.asp until May 1, 2026. It is available in 18 different languages, and the survey will take approximately 30 minutes to complete
