YDI Survey for Grade 11's - February 18
Our Grade 11 students will be writing [The Youth Development Instrument \(YDI\)](#). This online self-reported survey is implemented by researchers from the [CHART Lab](#) at Simon Fraser University (SFU), and it helps to identify resources, opportunities and practices that affect positive youth development. It is administered annually and has been in place since 2020.

The YDI collects data that is used collectively, and not individually, to better understand the holistic developmental trends, health and well-being of adolescents in British Columbia. In the Spring Term, we receive a general report that summarizes how our students as a group are doing with their social, emotional and mental health. We use this data to provide a baseline of the overall health of our students in these areas, and it informs the supports we put in place for our students going forward.

Students will be invited to complete the 35 – 40 min online survey. **The YDI will be implemented at our school on February 18, 2026, during our CLC Conference Day.**

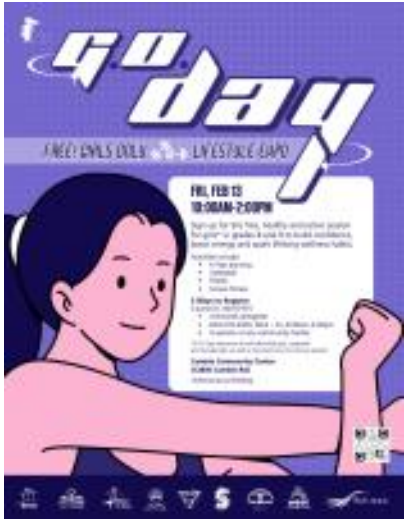
